IASH 2017, the 15th **International Conference on Stability, Handling and Use of Liquid Fuels** will be comprised of four days of technical sessions, with a separate poster session. The latter will provide an opportunity for technical presentations on new and innovative approaches to the definition and solution of fuel stability and handling problems. A commercial exposition will run throughout the symposium. IASH conferences are held biennially.

Papers or posters on all aspects of the sustainability and use of fossil fuels, synthetic fuels and renewable fuels are invited. Key aspects are stability, viability, unique properties and chemistry, carbon neutrality, handling and cleanliness control. These may relate to any liquid fuels including but not limited to gasoline, jet, diesel, burner, and residual fuel oils; crude oils; synthetic fuels, reformulated fuels; and fuels or blend stocks derived from biological materials, tar sands, oil shale and coal.

Abstracts of approximately 250 words, in English, are requested for both technical papers and poster papers to be submitted electronically to Patricia Lee, IASH Administrator, at plee@iash.net. Papers based on original, previously unpublished research or studies are preferable, but not mandatory. PPT presentation drafts are due 30 days prior to the conference for review by Pam Serino, Conference Chairwoman. Manuscripts are due on 30 September 2017.

Presenters will be responsible for travel expenses and the US\$1,000 Conference Registration Fee.

YOUNG RESEARCHER AWARD:

The Chevron Research Award of Excellence in Honor of John Bacha will be awarded at the conference. The award was created to encourage young scientists and engineers to join and enrich the industry. Encourage your young researchers to submit an abstract to be considered for the award. Recipients are required to be within five years of graduation and will present their paper at the conference.
